

Expression of Interest from Industry for collaboration in the area of Developing Diagnostic kits for Dengue severity detection

CSIR- Institute of Genomics and Integrative Biology (CSIR-IGIB) has been working in the area of genomic surveillance towards pathogens of concerns/ load in India to strengthen public health decision making. IGIB's pivotal role in clinical and community genomic surveillance of SARS-CoV-2 during COVID-19 pandemic is a testimony for this. During last few years, clinical Dengue genomic surveillance has been one of the significant efforts to understand why Dengue infects a large number of people in India/ tropical regions every year. Additionally, observed differential Dengue disease severity albeit infected by same/similar pathogen is also area of more research, including functional role of resident microbes. To this end, CSIR-IGIB invites Expression of Interest from academic and commercial organization (start-ups/diagnostic labs /hospitals /PSU's / Industries etc) with specialized know-how/ IP/ infrastructure etc for sharing of expertise, knowledge and resources for developing diagnostic kits towards dengue severity detection.
